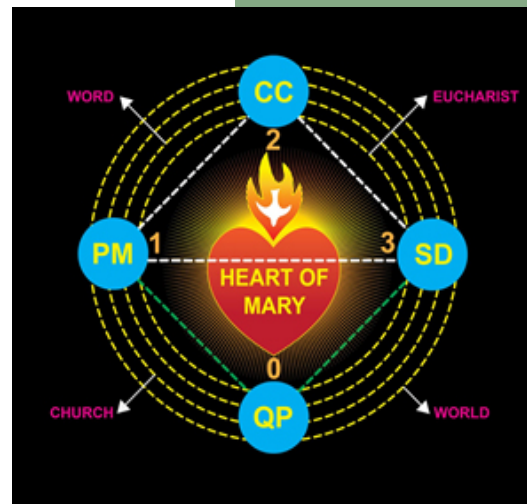

WHAT IS FORGE KEY?

Forge refers to the comprehensive formative/renewal paradigm developed by Claretian missionaries, inspired by the charismatic formative experience of their founder, Saint Anthony Mary Claret (1807-1870). In a deeply mystical experience, he found himself being formed in the forge of the Heart of Mary, to be transformed into an arrow poised to be released to evangelize the world.

Claretians have evolved the *Forge* as a comprehensive formative paradigm, in the spirit of *Vita Consecrata*, applicable to all consecrated men and women. The diagram below captures dynamics of the *Forge Encounter* tailor-made for the *initial formation* as well as for the *ongoing deepening* of one's religious consecration. The *Forge Encounter* unfolds in 0+3 phases, with the dynamics of each phase correlated to each person of the Trinity.



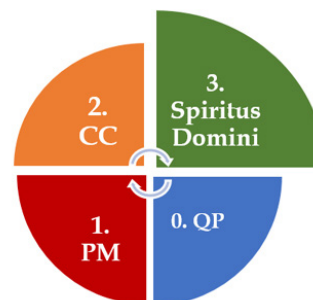
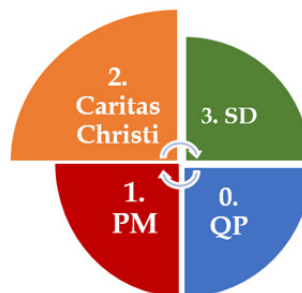
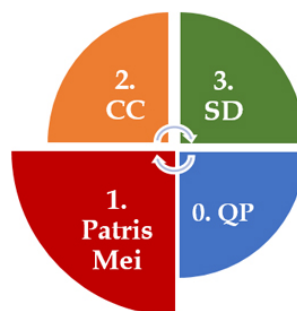
COURSE CONTENT

Phase 0: Quid Prodest ("What does it profit...?") is an introductory phase focusing on an invitation to self-awareness and self-examination that sets the tone for the rest of the phases. QP includes the What-Why-How of the IPPP. In line with the call of the Church document *Keep Watch!*

Phase 1: Patris Mei ("My Father") seeks to explore one's daughter-/son-ship with God, the Father. It includes themes such as: Theology of Vocation, Images of God, *Patris Mei* experience of Jesus, Mary, and one's own Founder, Word of God in Consecrated Life (CL), Psychological Aspects of CL, Healing the Inner Child, Prayer Workshop, Biblical Foundations of CL, and History of CL. In line with the call of the Church document *Rejoice!*

Phase 2: Caritas Christi ("Love of Christ"), as the central nucleus of the Forge Key explores one's configuration with Christ. Themes: Christification, Theology of Consecration, Evangelical Counsels, Eucharistic Foundation of CL, Community Living, and Group Therapy sessions. In line with the call of the Church document *Contemplate!*

Phase 3: Spiritus Domini ("The Lord's Spirit") inflames the charism within the candidate, completes the formation and launches one into mission as an arrow fired. Themes: Charism, Enneagram Awareness, Psycho-sexual and Psycho-spiritual Integration, Discernment, Spiritual Quotient, and Mission of the Consecrated Today. In line with the call of the Church document *Proclaim!*



The entire *Forge Encounter* concludes with a "Sending Forth" phase that includes a Retreat and gathering the fruits of the encounter.

OUTCOMES OF THE *IPPP-in-FORGE* KEY EXPERIENCE

- A lived experience of the Trinitarian foundation of one's consecration, with a deepening of intimacy with the Persons of the Trinity.
- Greater maturity in affective domain and growth in psycho-sexual and psycho-spiritual integration, aimed at deepening of one's inner freedom to profess the evangelical counsels.
- Greater personal agency to live one's consecration with integrity and creativity.
- Substantial grounding in the theology of consecrated life.
- Foundations for a joyful community living as witnesses of the Kin(g)dom.
- Skilling in discernment and various forms of prayer.

METHODOLOGY

A mixed methodology with a 60:40 ratio for input : processing. Includes lecture sessions, assignments, group discussions, audio-visuals and multi-media presentations, case studies, role play, core experiences, personal accompaniment through VGS (vocational growth sessions), and group therapy dynamics.
