COMPREHENSIVE EXAM</p> <p>In the final semester, the student takes a comprehensive written examination of three hours duration. The exam seeks to assess the integrated insights learned from the fundamental courses of the curriculum.</p>
<p>6. RESEARCH METHODOLOGY</p>	<p>E. DISSERTATION & DEFENSE</p> <p>In Semester II, the student chooses the research topic and the guide. Once approved, he/she begins the research. The student has three dates to defend the dissertation: end of the fourth semester; end of the next immediate odd semester; or end of the next immediate even semester.</p>
